

ORDINANCE NO. 1246

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE RIALTO MUNICIPAL CODE BY THE ADDITION OF CHAPTER 2.25 ESTABLISHING A RIALTO CABLE ADVISORY COMMISSION.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIALTO HEREBY ORDAINS AS

FOLLOWS:

Chapter 2.25 of the Rialto Municipal Code is added as follows:

2.25.010 Creation

There is created a Rialto Cable Advisory Commission.

A. The Rialto Cable Advisory Commission consists of seven members who are appointed by the mayor with the approval of the City Council. One Council member may be appointed by the mayor with approval of the City Council as an ex officio member of the commission.

B. The ex officio member is intended only as liaison member between the City Council and the Rialto Cable Advisory Commission. The ex officio member is not to be counted for quorum purposes nor be entitled to vote on any matter before the Rialto Cable Advisory Commission. The ex officio member does have all other rights and responsibilities of member of the Rialto Cable Advisory Commission.

2.25.030 Term of Office

Members of the commission serve for a period of four years. The first commission to be appointed shall, at its first meeting, classify its members by lot so that two serve two years, two serve three years and three serve four years. At the expiration of each of the terms so provided for a successor shall be appointed for a term of four years.

2.25.040 Vacancies

If a vacancy occurs otherwise than by expiration of a term, it is filled by appointment for the unexpired portion of the term.

2.25.050 Officers

The Rialto Cable Advisory Commission shall elect a chairperson and a vice-chairperson from among the appointed members. Officers hold office for one year, or until their successors are elected.

2.25.060 Meetings

The Rialto Cable Advisory Commission shall hold at least one regular meeting in each month. Four members constitute a quorum.

2.25.070      Functions

The functions of the commission are to:


A. Act in an advisory capacity to the City Council to develop strategies that maximize the Rialto Cable Advisory Commission's fiscal efficiency.

B. As necessary, consult with the Assistant City Administrator and/or the City Administrator regarding administrative/policy issues and fiscal matters pertaining to the Rialto Cable Advisory Commission.


C. With respect to PEG Access channels it shall be the Cable Advisory Board's responsibility, in cooperation with City Rialto KRTO staff, to:


1. Monitor the implementation of PEG Access programming.
2. Assure a sufficient variety of non-discriminatory PEG access programming to meet the needs of students, residents, and cable viewers in Rialto.
3. Promote interest in and use of PEG Access channels.
4. Act as an advisory body to the Rialto City Council with respect to PEG cable access.
5. Coordinate workshops.
