2.24.010 Creation. There is established a Rialto Utilities Commission. (Ord. 717 (part), 1977: 1965 code Title III, Ch. 5, §1.

2.24.020 Membership. The Rialto Utilities Commission consists of five members who are appointed by the mayor with the approval of the city council. (Ord. 717 (part), 1977: Ord. 634 §1 (part). 1972: 1965 code Title III, Ch. 5, §2).

2.24.030 Term of Office. Terms of office of the members of the Rialto Utilities Commission are for a period of four years commencing on the date of appointment, and such terms are staggered with the term of one member of the Rialto Utilities Commission expiring each year, except that every fourth year the terms of two members expire. (Ord. 717 (part), 1977: Ord. 634 §1 (part), 1972: 1965 code Title III, Ch. 5, §3).

2.24.040 Vacancies. Vacancies in the unexpired term are filled in the same manner as prescribed in Section 2.24.020. Members remain in office until their successors have been duly appointed and take office. (Ord. 717 (part), 1977: 1965 code Title III, Ch. 5, §4).

2.24.050 Functions. The Rialto Utilities Commission advises and makes recommendations to the city council on problems of public relations, standards of service, aquisition and/or franchising of utilities, rules and regulations and such other problems which the city council may submit. This commission also brings to the city council matters relative to water supply, wastewater quality control, and policies affecting the utilities division's operations which have come to their attention. (Ord. 717 (part), 1977: 1965 Title III, Ch. 5, §5).
