11 2.22.010 Creation.

12 Pursuant to the provisions of the California Planning and Zoning Law, Government  
13 Code §§ 65000 et seq., there is created a city planning commission for the city known as the  
Rialto city planning commission and may be referred to as the "planning commission."

14 2.22.020 Membership--Appointment.

15 The planning commission consists of seven members appointed by the Mayor with the  
16 approval of the City Council.

17 2.22.030 Term of office.

18 Terms of office of the members of the planning commission are for a period of four (4)  
19 years or until their successors are appointed and such terms are staggered with the terms of two  
(2) members of the planning commission expiring each year, except that every fourth year the  
term of only one (1) member expires.

20 The first planning commission to be appointed under this Section, as amended effective  
21 February, 1993, shall, at its first meeting, so classify its members by lot so that the existing  
22 planning commission members on such date serve their existing terms and so that the two (2)  
23 members being added to the planning commission by the amendment of this Section, effective  
February, 1993, serve four (4) years, with their terms expiring December 31, 1996.  
24 Successors to any of the appointed terms will be for four (4) year terms, except in the case of  
vacancies being filled. Terms expire on December 31st each year.

25 2.22.040 Vacancies.

26 If a vacancy occurs other than by expiration of a term, it is filled by appointment for  
the unexpired portion of the term.

27 2.22.050 Adoption of rules.

28 The planning commission adopts rules for the transaction of business and keeps a public  
record of its transactions, resolutions, findings and determinations.

1 **2.22.060 Officers.**

2 The planning commission elects a chairman and a vice chairman from among the  
3 appointed members. The planning commission appoints a secretary who need not be a member  
4 of the commission. Officers hold office for one (1) year, or until their successors are elected.

5 The planning commission may appoint such employees as it may deem necessary for its  
6 work. All such appointments are subject to approval by the City Council and the appropriation  
7 of funds therefor.

8 **2.22.070 Meetings.**

9 The planning commission holds at least one regular meeting in each month. Four (4)  
10 members constitute a quorum.


11 **2.22.080 Powers and duties.**

12 The planning commission has and performs the functions, duties and powers provided  
13 in the Planning and Zoning Law referred to in Section 2.22.010. The planning commission  
14 performs such other functions and duties with respect to zoning and other matters as the City  
15 Council may refer to the planning commission.


16 **2.22.090 Removal.**

17 The planning commission, and each of its members, serves, and may be removed, at  
18 the pleasure of the Mayor, with the consent of the City Council."




