



VEHICLE STORAGE & PARKING

On Private Property

When parking vehicles on your property, be sure to keep them on your driveway or in the garage. If vehicles are parked on front lawns or are visibly abandoned (not driven), it affects the look of the neighborhood.

- Parking a vehicle, trailer, or RV on front lawns and non-paved surfaces is prohibited. (10.28.292 RMC)
- Keeping or storing abandoned, wrecked, dismantled, or inoperative vehicles on any premises is prohibited. (9.26.030 RMC)
- Storing trucks, delivery vans, tractors, or other commercial vehicles used primarily for business which have a one-ton or more carrying capacity or exceed 10,000 pounds GVW in a residential zone is prohibited. (10.28.291)
- Parking or storing vehicles on vacant or undeveloped land is prohibited. (18.58.020 RMC)
