Community Clean-Up Day Activities

Rialto Residents Only
(Proof of Residency Required)
8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Shred Fest – Protect your identity. Shred your personal documents for free. Bring your papers to 150 S. Palm Ave. The shredding truck will be on site from **8 am to 2 pm** or until the truck is full.

Electronic Waste – Bring your televisions, microwaves, computers and monitors, and other electronics to 150 S. Palm Ave. to be recycled.

Usable Items – The Salvation Army will be accepting usable household items (such as clean clothing, shoes, furniture, sports equipment, etc.) at 150 S. Palm Ave.

Free Trash Disposal – Rialto residents can now dispose of trash, bulky items, and green waste for free. Bring Furniture, Mattresses, Scrap Metal, Toilets, Wood/Branches, Yard Trimmings etc. to 150 S. Palm Ave. for free disposal.

Used Tires – **Rialto City residents** can bring up to 9 used tires to the Public Works Office at 335 W. Rialto Ave on Community Clean-Up days for free disposal. We will not accept tires from businesses, including semi-trucks.

Household Hazardous Waste – Our Household Hazardous Waste Site, located at 246 S. Willow, will accept your used motor oil and filters, paint, household cleaners, pesticides, weed killers, batteries, syringes, fluorescent bulbs, medications and other household chemicals. **We can not accept explosives, medical waste, abandoned waste, or business waste.** *This site is free to all residents of San Bernardino County.*
