



## **City of Rialto Ambulance Membership Program**

The City and the Fire Department of Rialto are proud to offer you the opportunity to participate in our membership program. Every subscription member supports the efforts of the firefighters and paramedics of the Rialto Fire Department.

### **MEMBERSHIP COST - \$60 A YEAR OR \$5 PER MONTH**

#### **Your Membership Ensures:**

- No out of pocket expense for emergency ambulance service.
- Emergency medical care and transportation from anywhere within the Rialto City Limits to hospital.
- Specially trained medical personnel.
- Emergency services free from red tape or claim forms.

#### **Household coverage:**

- For \$60 per year or \$5 per month, you and your dependents will receive emergency paramedic ambulance transportation with no cost to you. This benefit is available from anywhere within the City of Rialto.
- Your membership covers you and all of your dependents, when EMS is provide by Rialto Fire Paramedics.
- You and your dependents are completely protected, regardless of what your medical insurance pays or does not pay toward emergency paramedic ambulance transportation.

#### **Frequently Asked Questions**

**Q. What does the \$60 membership fee cover?**

**A.** *All emergency medical services provided by the Rialto Fire Department paramedics, including unlimited emergency medical transport to the hospital for one year.*

**Q. Who is covered by the membership?**

**A.** *You and your dependents.*

**Q. Will the membership cover routine ambulance transportation such as trips from a hospital to home or from a rest home to a hospital?**

**A.** *Currently, only emergency transportation from a scene in the City Rialto to a hospital is covered.*

**Q. Are visitors of residential members covered?**

**A.** *No, only you and your dependents are covered.*

**Q. Does membership cover me outside the City of Rialto?**

**A.** *No, not at this time.*

**Q. If I am retired and only have Medicare coverage, should I enroll in the membership program?**

**A.** *Yes, you should enroll. Medicare will not cover all of the direct fees and ambulance charges.*
