## Outside the Home

- ❖ Lawns need to be cut and maintained regularly
- ❖ There is no parking of vehicles on lawns or unpaved surfaces
- ❖ Abandoned, inoperable, or dismantled vehicles cannot be in view
- ❖ Junk, trash, debris, & furniture cannot be in public view
- ❖ If you want to get rid of a bulky item, contact Burrtec before placing appliances and bulky items near the curb.
- ❖ Keeps pools clean (no green) & gated/secured
- ❖ Do not leave vehicles on the street without moving every 72 hours
- ❖ Please also maintain your parkways

## Inside the Home

- ❖ There must be a smoke detector in every bedroom and a combination detector (smoke and carbon monoxide) in the hallway outside of the rooms. Have at least a smoke and carbon monoxide detector on each floor even if there are no bedrooms
- ❖ Water heaters need to be double strapped (earthquake safety).
- ❖ Keep appliances (hotplates, microwaves, crockpots, etc.) out of bedrooms
