Also offers a program for seniors with diabetes. Callers are mailed the name of a participating ophthalmologist near their home. Participating doctors provide medical eye exams and up to 1-year necessary treatment for conditions or diseases at no charge to patient. Eyeglasses, prescriptions, hospital services, and other medical services are not covered under the program. Must not have seen an ophthalmologist in 3 years or more. Must not have eye care insurance through an HMO or VA benefits.
