



SIDEWALK VENDORS

The City of Rialto is committed to keeping its residents and visitors safe while promoting a vibrant economy. SB946 changed the requirements for sidewalk vendors, but not food trucks.

SB946 did not change the requirements for home occupations or selling items from a residence. A business license is still required to operate a business from home.

REMEMBER: Sidewalk vendors still require a business license and food vendors also require a County of San Bernardino Health Permit.

What is Required to Legally Operate in the City of Rialto as a Sidewalk Vendor?

- ❖ If you are selling food you need a San Bernardino County Environmental Health Service Permit.
- ❖ Food vendors need to comply with CalCode.
- ❖ ALL vendors (food, services, or merchandise) need a City of Rialto business license.
- ❖ Selling merchandise or food from your home that creates foot or vehicle traffic by customers is prohibited.

Regulations of Sidewalk Vendors (RMC 11.20)

1. Operate in residential zones only from 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM.
2. Litter receptacle available for patrons.
3. Clean-up all trash associated to the business.
4. No additional tables, crates, racks, or other devices besides the trailer or cart.
5. Do not solicit or conduct business with persons in a motor vehicle.
6. Do not operate within 15 feet of a driveway.
7. **4-foot clear space around cart on the public sidewalk for ADA access.**
8. Can only operate on streets with a sidewalk.
9. Cannot operate in the parking lot of a City park.
10. No advertising except on the cart or trailer. No A-frame signs or signs directing people to your location.
